

## Finance Internship Opportunity

Impact investments are those which generate social and environmental value as well as financial return. Impact investing is a rapidly growing field attracting many new and traditional investors. In order to facilitate this positive trend, **Imprint Capital Advisors** has teamed up with the **Rockefeller Foundation** and the **Global Impact Investing Network** to create a comprehensive, searchable database of impact investment fund managers and investment products. The goal is to lower search and transaction costs for investors, a key step in reaching scale and industry maturity.

Tasks will include:

- Supporting the development of the first industry-wide database of impact investment products and fund managers. Working with investors to demonstrate use of the database.

- Fact checking and research on impact investment funds, products and managers.
